


THE STATE OF YOUR COOPERATIVE

For Central Virginia Electric Cooperative, 2010 was an eventful year. CVEC dealt successfully with weather challenges, developed new programs for its members, and sought out power supply solutions for the future.

In February of 2010, more than two feet of snow fell across the Cooperative service area, creating widespread power outages which affected more than 10,000 CVEC members. Our crews worked tirelessly and, along with some help from several cooperatives from other states, service was restored to every account within six days.

Later in the year, CVEC members saw higher bills due to temperatures soaring in June and July, with cooling degree days 35% higher than normal for those two months. As the year closed, December again brought extreme temperatures, and bills rose again as members ran their heating systems to deal with heating degree days that were also 35% above normal (www.degreedays.net). After years of upgrading and improving our system to prepare for extreme loading, your Cooperative was able to withstand the extreme temperatures without overloading any circuits.



In June of 2010, CVEC issued capital credit refunds for the first time since 2003. We are issuing those refunds again in 2011 and we intend to make that an annual event. The return of capital credits is unique to cooperatives as we return to you a portion of the contribution you have made to help us finance the Cooperative's lines and stations.

In December, we performed a member survey. This year, the survey was based on questions that allowed CVEC to be scored on the American Consumer Satisfaction Index (ACSI). The ACSI measure is used by many companies in various industries nationwide.

In the December survey, based on responses from our members CVEC scored an 84, which is an excellent score. This score is above average for electric cooperatives, and well ahead of Dominion (76) and American Electric Power (73). CVEC also beat out Best Buy (77) and UPS (82) and scored just below Apple (86). The survey results validate that our efforts to meet members' needs are working, and we appreciate the support we get from our members.

Another major topic in the CVEC office throughout the year was power supply. CVEC is committed

to developing a diverse mix of contracts and assets that do not depend on a single company or fuel to meet the future needs of our members.

During the year, CVEC staff, along with a team of consultants, reviewed opportunities to invest in biomass projects, landfill methane projects, hydroelectric and natural gas projects. We reviewed contracts that would deliver power from nuclear plants, wind farms, solar projects, and from the wholesale market mix of resources. The Cooperative searched far and wide to find the best solutions and the best fit for the members of CVEC.



One of the most promising projects was a large hydroelectric development in Ohio. CVEC was invited into the project as a partner with American Municipal Power (AMP). We announced our intention to take a portion of the output from the projects and went through all of the steps to secure an \$85 million loan from the Rural Utilities Service and receive Virginia State Corporation Commission approval. Ultimately, at the time of the final contract consideration, the project became too expensive for CVEC compared to other market options for the first fifteen years of the plant operation. Due to increasing construction costs, the additional transmission costs to move the electricity from Ohio into central Virginia, and lower prices in the wholesale market through 2025, the Cooperative chose to step away from the project. We went into the project planning knowing we would pay a premium for a renewable resource with no future fuel costs, but the premium became too large to justify in the end.

We did sign a ten-year contract with Exelon to serve about ten percent of our needs for a ten-year period starting in 2012. We anticipate signing several more similar contracts this year that will begin delivery in 2015. We have purchased the small Harris Bridge Hydro plant at Schuyler, and this year we will perform some upgrades to maximize the benefits of that plant.

We are continuing to pursue the possibility of participation in a large solar project with AMP. We are still considering partnerships and contracts for several plants, including two natural gas facilities. We are also continuing to talk to a number of power suppliers about long term commitments to taking output from a plant or mix of plants.

Finally, we are very close to signing an all-requirements contract for the three-year period of June 2012 through June 2015. We anticipate that this contract will be signed before the Annual Meeting this year, giving us assurance of our cost of electricity for the next three years.

The good news about this contract is that the prices are significantly lower than they would have been two years ago; the bad news is that there will still be a one-time large increase in rates in June 2012, adding an average of \$20 to \$25 monthly to residential bills. While this is a large increase, the resulting bills will be in a range similar to other neighboring utilities. CVEC members have had the good fortune of paying significantly less than their neighbors for most of the last ten years, but in 2012 the cost of electricity will make us pay rates more in line with the industry average.



Finally, in 2010, CVEC began planning programs to provide more energy efficiency and conservation information to our members. You will hear a lot about this over the next year as we try to help members make wise decisions about electric usage. The best way to keep your bill low next year is simply not to buy as much, and as your not-for-profit Cooperative, we want to help you use only what you need. ☺

COUNTDOWN TO 75

A Major Milestone

Next year our Cooperative will celebrate 75 years of service to our members. While most of us have not been around that long, there are a few Co-op members who remember the day that CVEC "cut on the lights" at their home for the first time. It was a big day. Life was about to change, slowly at first, but dramatically over time.

As we count down to our 75th Anniversary, let's open up the archives and share our story. Many Co-op members know the story well. To others, who are not familiar with the cooperative business model, you might be surprised to discover that electricity might not be here today without the early efforts of a few hundred farmers and business owners.

What Was It Really Like

75 years ago, only one out of ten Virginia families had electricity. In rural areas, if you had electric service it was either because you owned a Delco generator, lived near a water mill, or you were located in an area served by one of the for-profit electric companies who were attracted to the large electric loads found in the population-dense county seat, at mining operations, or in fruit and vegetable cold storage facilities along the railroad tracks.

That meant that rural families in Virginia led a much different existence than their city cousins. In many ways it was like camping with a roof over your head. Heating and cooking was done by fire. Light came from sunshine and oil lamps. Animals and hand tools helped with the work. Food was cooled in a spring house. People hauled water to the home for cooking and drinking and they traveled to the outhouse when necessary. A Saturday night bath was shared by the family, one-by-one, until the baby was clean and bathwater thrown out. Laundry was a two-day affair with boiling water and six-pound irons, adding misery to the August heat.

Long Miles and Low Density

Like high speed Internet today, there was a disparity of available electric service in 1936. City dwellers had it and rural residents mostly did without. When rural families asked for service from the large electric companies in the 1920's and 30's, they were told that it would be too expensive to build lines to serve so few people, with estimates of \$2000 per



line mile and only 4-5 customers along the way. (Co-ops later installed lines for \$1000 per mile.)

Not only was there an "electric service divide" between urban and rural residents but that gulf had been endured for some time. Richmond, Virginia, received electric service beginning in the mid 1880's. Fifty years later, their country cousins were still waiting for service, waiting patiently but with little reason for hope. Urban families moved forward with new amenities and time-saving appliances. Rural residents fell behind.

The Depression, the New Deal and the Big Leap

Then opportunity arrived. The Rural Electrification Administration (REA) offered low interest loans to for-profit utilities if they would extend their lines to rural areas. When the for-profits declined the offer, the REA offered the same loan packages to farmers and families if they would create their own electric companies, using the cooperative business model. 400 people came together in Lovingston, Virginia, in 1937 to do just that. Each paid \$5.00 to establish a membership and their \$2,000 secured a \$100,000 REA loan to build the first electric lines.

Had it not been for the New Deal programs and the determination of the first Cooperative members, rural electrification might have been further delayed. It likely would still be unavailable in some areas to this day due to the economics of serving rural areas. Consider this. Electric cooperatives serve more than 75% of the land area in the continental U.S., while only serving 12% of the population.

Today we often take electric service for granted unless we are temporarily inconvenienced due to a storm or falling tree. In reality, we are fortunate that those early members seized the opportunity to create their own electric Co-op, guaranteeing a better life for their own families then as well as our families today.

CAPITAL CREDITS: One of the Member Benefits

CVEC operates under the cooperative business model, member-owned, not-for-profit, and governed by a board of directors elected by the members to represent our interest. As such, distribution lines are constructed and maintained at actual costs. Energy is purchased in bulk and delivered to members without a price markup that is typical of for-profit utilities.

At the end of the year, if there is money remaining after all of the bills are paid, each member is allocated a share of the remaining money based upon their energy usage. The allocated share is known as a capital credit and these are reinvested in the physical plant for a period of time before being returned to the members. The total amount of capital credits invested in the physical plant is comparable to the equity that many us have in our home. CVEC's equity level is about 28% of the total plant value with the remaining 72% having been paid with long-term loans.

On occasion, the Board of Directors will vote to return capital credits to CVEC members, both past and present. CVEC has operated with razor-thin margins, which have kept capital credits low and capital credits refunds infrequent. CVEC has

operated like the individual who pays lower taxes throughout the year but does not get much of a refund come tax time.

The CVEC Board of Directors has decided that it would be prudent to increase the Cooperative's equity level, in large part to respond to changes in the wholesale energy market, where financial ratios can affect the terms of an energy contract. This is important since energy is the largest single component of your energy dollar, typically 55-60%.

While CVEC adjusted our rates slightly, beginning this month to increase our equity levels and other financial ratios, the byproduct of that adjustment is that each CVEC member should begin to look for a capital credit refund on an annual basis if all goes well throughout the year and no extraordinary expenses are encountered. Look on your electric bill for a line item credit if your refund is less than \$25 and look for a check in the mail if your refund is larger.

Service and energy delivered to you at cost and capital credits refunded to you the CVEC member-owner. 🍀

Excerpt from CVEC Bylaws Related to Unclaimed Capital Credits.

SECTION 7.4 - Donated Capital. Notwithstanding any other provision of the Bylaws or provisions of the membership certificate, if any Patron or former Patron fails to claim any cash retirement of Capital Credits or other payment from the Cooperative within one year after payment of the same has been made available to the Patron or former Patron by notice or check mailed to the Patron or former Patron at the last address furnished by the Patron or former Patron to the Cooperative, such failure shall be and constitutes an assignment and gift by such Patron or former Patron of such Capital Credit or other payment to the Cooperative. Failure to claim any such payment within the meaning of this Section shall include the failure of such Patron or former Patron to cash any check mailed to the Patron or former Patron by the Cooperative at the last address furnished by the Patron or former Patron to the Cooperative. The assignment and gift provided for under this Section shall become effective only upon the expiration of one year from the date when such payment was made available to such Patron or former Patron without claim therefore and only after further expiration of one hundred twenty days following the giving of a notice by publication that unless such payment is claimed within said one hundred twenty day period, such gift to the Cooperative shall become effective. The notice herein provided shall be published in the Cooperative's consumer newsletter and a publication of general circulation. The one hundred twenty day period following the giving of such notice shall be deemed to terminate one hundred twenty days following the last date of publication thereof.

Notwithstanding the provisions of the foregoing paragraph, any Patron or former Patron may at any time revoke an assignment or gift of Capital Credits to the Cooperative by appearing at the main office of the Cooperative in Nelson County, Virginia, and furnishing proof of identity entitling the Patron or former Patron to the Capital Credits.

List of Unclaimed Credits

In 2010, CVEC issued capital credit refunds to members who had service with us in 1983 and issued a 20% capital credit refund to members who had service with the Co-op in 2009. Current members received their refund as a check or a credit on their bill. Checks for former members were mailed to their last address known to CVEC. The post office returned a number of those checks as undeliverable. Following is a list of members who have not claimed their refunds.

Today the average residential member uses about 1300 kilowatt-hours of electricity costing a little under \$120 for our heating, cooling, appliances and gadgets.

Due to a long-term energy contract, CVEC members have been paying less for electric service than their friends and neighbors served by other utilities. CVEC is your best energy value! 🍀



Wholesale Power, Higher Rates in 2012, and Energy Efficiency

By now, you have probably heard that your Co-op will pay more for wholesale energy after May 31, 2012. This is due to the end of a great 10-year wholesale energy contract.

Over the past 10 years, the wholesale energy market has changed. Wall Street brokers and investment banks are trading energy like any other commodity. The risk and costs have been shifted to the wholesale buyer. Prices have risen and our friends



and neighbors served by other utilities have been paying much more than our fellow Co-op members for quite some time. While final terms have not been reached on the new energy contract, CVEC anticipates that members who presently pay \$100 for a monthly bill will likely pay \$125 in June of 2012.

Over the next year, CVEC will be discussing the status of the new wholesale energy contract (Co-op members purchase energy in bulk and split the cost based upon usage) and we will be discussing ways to reduce consumption through energy efficiency efforts. CVEC Offers Renewable Energy Certificates

If you are one of the members who would like to purchase “green energy” but want to avoid the costly investment of a solar or wind system, then your Co-op now has an alternative for you. CVEC has purchased wind-generated renewable energy certificates (REC’s) through the Old Dominion Electric Cooperative.

How does it work? Remember that electric utilities cannot capture and guide electrons from a renewable energy generator and then direct them to your house. People who want to purchase green energy through the market must rely on a certificate system, where the output of a green energy generator like wind, solar, bio-mass, wave motion, geo-thermal, etc., is measured and converted to a tradable certificate.

These certificates can then be purchased by anyone who wants to add the renewable energy component to their regular electricity. In this instance, the owner of the wind generator keeps the energy that was generated but sells the green aspect of that energy in the form of a certificate, which is then tracked and retired. In addition to wind power, CVEC will produce REC’s from the output of the Rockfish Bridge Hydro Plant on the Rockfish River, and a 2 KW photovoltaic system owned and operated by the Co-op.

How do you sign up? Visit www.mycvec.com to read about “Rider R” and then download the registration form. CVEC will begin billing you for the Renewable Energy Rate which is your present energy rate plus an additional 1.5¢ per kilowatt-hour. So, if you use 1000 kwh per month, that would add an additional \$15 to your electric bill. 🍀




